Patchogue, NY - The Fire Island Lighthouse Preservation Society will host photographer Audrey Tiernan this Sunday, August 6 to celebrate the unveiling of a new photographic display. The display includes Tiernans images from the new book *Fire Island Lighthouse: Long Island's Welcoming Beacon*, published with support from the [Robert D. L. Gardiner Foundation](#). The event begins at 1:00 pm at the Fire Island Lighthouse Fresnel Lens Building.

The Fire Island Lighthouse offers exhibits, a nature trail, and interpretive and curriculum-based programs. The lighthouse is operated by the Fire Island Lighthouse Preservation Society under a cooperative agreement with the National Park Service and is open daily. The lighthouse is located on the west end of Fire Island National Seashore and is accessible year-round by car. Parking is available at Robert Moses State Park in parking field #5.
